

Jr. High Youth Rally Dress Code and Code of Conduct:

You are representing your parish and the Archdiocese of Indianapolis; therefore, appropriate dress and conduct that reflects Catholic Christian values is expected at all events.

DRESS CODE:

- Pants & shorts must be worn at the waistline - no sagging or undergarments can be visible.
- Shoes or sandals must be worn at all times.
- Shirts/tops must have an appropriate neckline (no lower than 4 finger-widths from the collarbone).
- Shoulders and stomachs must be covered; no mesh or see-through clothing
- No spaghetti straps, halter tops, tube tops, or sport bras. Tank top straps must be at least 1½" in width.
- Appropriate length shorts must be worn – walking short or school uniform approved length.
- Tight-fitting clothing is never allowed and undergarments must not be visible through the clothing.
- No t-shirts with alcohol, cigarettes, or disrespectful/offensive sayings or logos.
- If your attire is determined to be inappropriate, you may be asked to wear a t-shirt or be sent home.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

- The possession or consumption of any alcohol or tobacco is NOT allowed.
- The possession of illegal drugs or weapons will result in having local police contacted.
- No foul or inappropriate language.
- No PDA (public display of affection) is allowed, including but not limited to kissing, holding hands, or inappropriate touching.
- Throwing of objects and loud or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- No carrying people on shoulders.
- No back talking.
- You are to remain at the event for the duration.
- If you are asked to leave the event, you may not return.
- You are required to abide by the Dress Code.
- Your parents will be notified if you fail to abide by the rules.
- Youth are expected to respect their peers, the speakers, and adult leaders who are there to assist them.
- Participants are expected to attend all Rally events.
- Nametags must be worn at all times. They will allow admission to all activities, including the concert and dinner.
- Dress for the Rally is casual, however, no clothing with obscene or offensive language, symbols or pictures will be permitted.
- Participants are to remain in Roncalli High School during the duration of the Rally.
